Chore	\$15.00 to \$50.00 per hour for lawn work and most chore services. \$10.00 per completed errand and essential shopping.
Loan Closet	\$5.00 to \$25.00 for small durable medical equipment such as canes, walkers, grabbers, shoe horns, raised toilet seats, dressing sticks, etc. \$20.00 to \$50.00 for large durable medical equipment such as wheelchairs, transfer chairs, shower chairs, transfer benches, stationary commodes, rollator walkers with a seat, etc.
Matter of Balance Class	\$15.00 to \$30.00 for the 8-week series.
Outreach	\$15.00 to \$25.00 per hour. \$15.00 to \$25.00 per Medicare Part D assistance.
Telephone Reassurance	\$5.00 to \$10.00 per month.
Transportation	\$10.00 to \$20.00 for in county medical and non-medical transports. \$20.00 to \$30.00 for brief out-of-county medical transports. (Office visits less than 2 hours.) \$30.00 to \$40.00 for extended out-of-county medical transports. (Office visits longer than 2 hours.)
